Napa-inspired Gaslamp outpost Route 29 has debuted with a variety of signature cocktails on its list, including signature cocktails including their Acai Bowl with cachaça, acai root, lime, and organic agave; the Tokyo Tea with coconut lemongrass sake, vodka, lemon, and ginger beer and the Golden Gate, made with organic tequila, passion fruit, turmeric, carrot, lime, egg whites, and agave.
